WHAT TO BRING

- -Bible & notebook
- -Swimsuit (one piece only) and towel on swim days
- -Sneakers or closed toed shoes, socks (must be worn), shower shoes, raincoat, and light sweater.
 - -Young campers, or campers who are at risk of having Accidents, should bring a change of clothes each day

WHAT NOT TO BRING (Campers and Visitors)

- -No electronic devices including cell phone, TV, mp3 player, ipods, ipads, CD players, etc. . . . magazines, guns-real or play, knives, playing cards, non-prescription drugs, tobacco, alcoholic beverages. no food is allowed in the cabins.
- -Toilet articles: Deodorant, lotion, sunscreen (SPF 15 or higher). Staff will supervise the application of sunscreen but are unable to apply sunscreen to your child unless it is in spray form (Please label everything).

THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW

- -All campers are covered by Accident Insurance.
- -Please mark all articles of clothing with camper's name.
- -All necessary medications should be presented in their original packaging.
- -Lost and found articles will be kept for 30 days. Please call as soon as soon as you discover lost item. Unclaimed articles are given to qualified charitable organizations.

DRESS CODE (campers and visitors)

All clothing and shorts must be modest. **No Short-shorts** or **Miniskirts**. No see-through tops and tops must be long enough to cover waist. No halter tops: dresses and tops must have 2" wide shoulder straps. No improper mottos or advertising. No two-piece swimsuits. TCBC will ask any individual to change clothing, if it is deemed inappropriate.
